

# Lucky 7 Series Rules

The Lucky 7 Series is designed to reward consistency, commitment, and performance throughout the 2026 show season. Five saddles will be awarded at the end of the show year to the highest scoring horse and rider in eligible horse show class divisions.

## Scoring Rules

- Competitors must attend a minimum of 5 shows to be eligible. If all 7 shows are attended, all 7 scores will count.
- Scores are based on composite totals (rein work + cow work)
- Each class division is tracked individually. Scores cannot be combined across different classes
- The same horse & rider combination in Non Pro / Youth must be maintained throughout the series
- The Open division is calculated based on the horse, allowing for changes in ownership or riders if needed.
- Youth competitors are only eligible to run at youth divisions for year end saddles

*Example:*

*For a Non Pro competitor showing in both Non Pro Bridle and Non Pro Two Rein scores will be tracked for each class separately. Scores from different classes cannot be combined to create a higher total.*
